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Club Rules

It is the responsibility of all members and visitors to the Club to acquaint themselves with the rules of the Club. Any member or visitor to the Club, not adhering to the above rules, makes himself/herself liable to corrective action.

GENERAL RULES ON THE CLUB GROUNDS:

- The right of admission is reserved: the Committee may declare any person/s to be forbidden entrance to the Club and its grounds.
- No alcohol is permitted to enter the club.
- No 2 litre cool drinks are allowed on the club grounds
- Membership Numbers must be presented on request whilst on Club Grounds.
- All signs located on the club premises are considered part of the clubs and enjoy the same status as the rules contained in this document.
- The use of all Clubs facilities is at your own risk.
- No dogs or other pets are permitted in the Lapa, campers may bring a small dog provided special permission is obtained from the committee, and a permit obtained at the office. (with special conditions)
- Only persons who have been authorized by the committee may enter the back office, kitchen, storerooms, compressor room, storage containers, workshop, staff ablutions and change rooms or be behind the bar.
- No ball games / bikes and roller skates allowed in the Lapa.
- Dress code in the Lapa is anything goes that is modest, dry and free of sand and dirt. A shirt or vest is always required in the Lapa.
- No smoking (including vaping and electronic cigarettes) in or under any covered or partially covered area and any areas on the premises as determined by committee, such as near fuel storage areas, Lapa, kitchen and compressors. Smoking (including vaping and the use of electronic cigarettes) is strictly limited to the designated and open areas.
- No crockery, cutlery, glasses, braai grills or utensils may be removed from the Lapa/kitchen facility.
- The Lapa may **not** be used for any private function unless specific consent is given by the management or committee, which shall have an unfettered discretion to allow or disallow any function at any time (written application by email to be lodged a month in advance.)
- The venue at the admin building is available for functions and parties, this can be booked at the reception. The venue is not open to non-members. A member can stand good for a non-member who books the venue but will be fully responsible for their behaviour. A minimum of R1500 must be spent at the upstairs bar to cover stock placement and staff cost for the evening.
- Club Grounds are to be kept clean and neat.

- Bad behaviour, foul language and being a nuisance to others are not acceptable on Club Grounds. Members will be responsible for the behaviour of their families and visitors.
- Vandalism will not be tolerated. Members will be held responsible for any damage caused by them, their visitors, or their families.
- No fireworks are allowed to be set off on Club grounds.

CHILDREN

- No Children under the age of 18 to be left at the club without supervision.
- It is the responsibility of the parents or guardians to always supervise and ensure the safety of their children while on the premises. This includes but is not exclusive to:
 - (a) The roads/routes along which boats and tractors traverse to and from the premises to the slipway.
 - (b) The swimming pool (no lifeguards).
 - (c) The playground.
- The RBSBC furthermore advises all parents that neither the Club, nor the committee take any responsibility for any injury or mishap which may occur to children at any time.
- Children are not permitted to play in the Lapa or to make excessive noise.
- The toilets may not be used by any child under the age of eight (8) years, unless such a child is accompanied by an adult.

PARKING AND ACCESS

- Club members are required to do a facial recognition at the gate. No vehicles will be allowed on the grounds without a positive scan being carried out. If your annual subs are not up to date access will be denied, disc on vehicle windscreen must be displayed to get through security check point.
- Caravan Park residents may bring in alcohol provided they can show a valid disc to the guard at the gate and may only be consumed at the Campsite.
- Vehicle with temporary access to the caravan park, must present their disc it at the gate.
- The speed limit on Club grounds is 10km/h.
- Members are required to meet their invited guests at the gate to allow them access. Gate Guards may require proof of membership before allowing guests access.
- Cars may not be parked in the designated area for the washing of boats, or in any area that may cause an obstruction to the Club's operations and various storage facilities.
- No boats or trailers to be left unattended for extended periods in front of garages or elsewhere on the club grounds without prior authorization and payment of the applicable fee.
- All fuel purchases must be settled by either cash or garage/petrol card. No fuel will be sold on credit.
- No Quad Bikes or unlicensed Motorcycles allowed on the grounds.

GUEST / VISITORS

- NO GUEST MAY BE AT THE CLUB PREMISES WITHOUT THE MEMBER BEING PRESENT. The member must be the first to arrive and the last to leave when guests are invited to Club. Such guests shall be entitled to remain upon the premises only so long as the member is also on the premises.
- ALL GUESTS ARE TO BE SIGNED IN BY THE MEMBER ON EVERY VISIT TO THE PREMISES and purchase a ticket for each visitor at R 30.00 per ticket (**max 4 non-members per membership number**) and shall furthermore be responsible for the behaviour of such guests while the guest is on the Club premises.
- A member must sign in a non-member Visitors vehicle, ticket is R50-00 a vehicle.
- NO GUEST MAY VISIT THE CLUB MORE THAN TWICE A MONTH. (You can obtain permission by the committee in writing asking for exemption if you have family visiting from out of town).

- MORE THAN 10 ADULT GUESTS (NON-MEMBERS) INVITED BY A MEMBER CONSTITUTES A FUNCTION and the Club Committee must be notified and approval obtained for the function before the guests arrive to ensure that the facilities can cope with the extra demand.
- No member shall introduce anyone, nor shall any person use the premises:
 - a) whose presence in the opinion of the committee or management is undesirable.
 - b) who has been rejected as a member or expelled or suspended from membership.
 - c) who has been struck off the list of members (of either of the clubs) for non-payment of subscriptions or other liabilities; or
 - d) who acts against the interests and reputation of club by verbal, social media comments or by any other means.
- Members shall pay for any damages caused by any guest introduced by them.

LIQUOR /BARS

- No children under the age of 18 are allowed in any bar or within 3m of an area serving alcohol.
- RBSBC is a licensed premises and as such, no alcohol may be brought on to the premises without permission of the committee which permission may be withheld. Corkage is payable on those items permitted.
- No person shall be permitted to purchase any liquor on credit.
- No liquor shall be removed from the premises; liquor purchased in the Lapa is for consumption on the premises.
- Members shall exercise restraint, particularly in regard to boisterous behaviour or the use of bad language in the bar.
- Any person who is asked by the barman or committee member to leave the bar and who subsequently fails to do so shall be liable to disciplinary action. No bar service will be afforded any persons, within the Lapa, unless such persons are wearing a shirt or vest, and footwear.
- No firearms allowed in the Lapa.

WATERCRAFT

- All watercraft shall be registered and inspected in the manner and upon the date advertised from time to time upon the premises.
- The failure by any watercraft owner, skipper or crew member to observe the safety and other regulations issued by SAMSA, or any other relevant authorities such as Transnet and SAPS or the committee at any time, may be in breach of said rules
- The owner of any watercraft shall be fully responsible for any acts or any omission by the skipper of his watercraft, or any crew member.
- All persons (skippers) are required to lodge the particulars in the launch register or contact the launch control in the duty room by radio upon launching or upon return.
- Area in front of Slipways & Jetty is a "No Wake Zone".
- No powered vessel with more than 15hp may be operated by a person not in possession of a C.O.F. (skipper's ticket), unless accompanied by a qualified skipper.
- All boats must complete the launch sheet in full before and after launch, this includes catch returns.
- Boats returning later than their logged ETA shall be liable for a fine of R150. Skippers may change their ETA by radio with the duty officer.
- Trailers should be parked orderly in the trailer park to ensure adequate capacity at busy times.
- Trailers may only be parked on the grass next to the duty room once the boat park is full.
- Area around the slipways to be kept clear in consideration for other members.
- Jetty is to be used with consideration for others.

- No boats may be tied to the jetty except for short periods by sport fishers to allow for the offload and weigh of fish.
- Boat speed in Bay maximum of 6 Knots in the “No Wake Zone”.
- Powering boats onto trailers could damage propellers and engines; users do this entirely at their own risk.
- Please keep Jetty clean and don’t leave old bait unattended.
- Boats must be removed from the washing bay immediately after boats have been washed.
- Fish cleaning area must be left clean, and all waste must be put into the bin.
- It is the responsibility of the watercraft owner to hand in copies of the C.O.F. and skippers’ ticket yearly to the office.
- The sale of fish on the Club Premises is prohibited.
- Only children under the age of 12 and crewmembers who cannot swim must wear life jackets or personal buoyancy aids while the vessel is in motion.
- Killswitch’s lanyard must always be attached to the skipper while the vessel is in motion/ engine in gear. Exception to this rule is only when you are doing surf launching.

JET-SKI AND E-CLASS WATERCRAFT

- All Jet-ski and E/R Class watercraft must register at the Radio Control room before launching.
- All Jet-ski and E/R Class watercraft must sign back at the Radio Control room upon return.
- Non-Skipper license holders (children) must be under direct supervision of the holder of such skipper’s license. (Either on the Jet-ski or nearby with another Jet-ski). Control may not be exercised from land.
- All necessary registered paperwork (seaworthy, skippers license, harbour permit, etc.) must be presented to the Radio room operator on request.
- All operators and passengers wear life jackets whilst in motion.
- No watercraft is to be operated by any person under the influence of alcohol.
- All Jet-ski and E/R Class watercraft operators must know the limits set for their craft.
- Copies of rules and regulations can be obtained from the office.
- Violating these rules can lead to disciplinary action.
- All watercrafts must keep direction of flow as determined for that day.

GARAGES & LOCKERS

- All lessees must be the owner of the boat.
- No Garage or Locker Lessee are allowed to sub-lease.
- All lessees of garages and lockers are required to perform 12 launches per annum. (No crew launches).
- All Lessees need to keep a record/Logbook of their 12 launches, to enable the committee to verify their launches.
- Any monthly payment overdue after 7 days or receiving a notification of overdue amount will result in cancellation of the contract and boats will have to be removed immediately.
- No living/sleeping in Boat Locker & enclosures.
- If a lessee, who must be the registered boat owner, sells their boat, the garage/locker lease shall not be transferable to the new boat owner. The lessee must vacate the garage/locker, which will then be offered to the next eligible boat owner on the waiting list.

SWIMMING POOL

- Swimming is at your own risk; no lifesavers will be on duty at any time.
- All small children and non-swimmers must be under adult supervision.
- No bottles or glasses in the swimming pool area.

- No loud music and parties aloud in the swimming area.

SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

- Members are at all times considered representatives of the clubs and should behave in a responsible manner on social media when doing so in the clubs' names or when mentioning the clubs on social media.
- Club members are not to post comments on social media platforms that bring RBSBC into disrepute.
- Members are to raise any complaints and concerns with the committee in writing and not post to social media.
- RBSBC has an information What's App group "**RBSBC All Members**" to send out club information and messages to members. If you do not have What's App on your cell phone, please go to Google Play store or Apple store to install it.
- RBSBC Skippers group was started by the skippers to share information on catches, pictures of their daily catches, weather predictions and other relevant information. This is a two-way group, and we urge members not to use this platform for slandering other members.
- This is a member's club, and we urge members to get involved and assist the committee. We as the committee cannot be at the club 24/7, please help us and report any wrongdoing, thank you.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN INSTITUTION OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION AFTER WHICH THE COMMITTEE MAY PLACE SANCTION UPON THE MEMBER INCLUDING SUSPENSION FROM THE CLUB FOR AGGREGIOUS VIOLATIONS.
